

Safer Driving Instructor Campaign - Terms and Conditions

1. The promoter is NRMA Safer Driving Schools Pty Limited ABN 12 122 086 248 of 9 Murray Rose Avenue, Sydney Olympic Park, NSW 2127 (**Promoter** or **NRMA**).

Start-up incentive

2. The NRMA is offering a limited number of driving instructor positions with the NRMA Driver Training School during the incentive Period to Eligible Applicants (defined below) (**Incentive**).
3. To be eligible to take up this incentive, a person must, during the Incentive Period:
 - a. be aged 21 years or over;
 - b. hold a full, unrestricted Australian drivers licence;
 - c. have no previous driver instructing experience; and or/
 - d. have the relevant NSW or ACT driving instructor accreditation (for further details see here for NSW and here for ACT); and
 - e. sign a consultancy agreement with NRMA Safer Driving Schools Pty Limited ABN 12 122 086 248 (**Consultancy Agreement**), (**Eligible Applicant**).
4. As part of the Incentive, the NRMA will provide to successful Eligible Applicants:
 - a. a subsidy on the cost of obtaining a Certificate IV in Transport and Logistics from an NRMA approved 'Registered Training Organisation, valued at up to \$4,000 for those applicants with no previous driver instructing experience
 - b. honorary NRMA Roadside Membership (Premium Care cover), valued at \$199 per year;
 - c. a reimbursement up to the value of \$4,000 on the cost of installing in new vehicles only: dual controls (in new vehicles without dual controls); and
 - d. NRMA livery (in new white vehicles only, additional costs to wrap new coloured vehicles will be at the Eligible Applicant's own cost); and .d access to NRMA fleet discounts for selected vehicle leases and purchases.
 - e. 4 day paid Instructor Induction training valued at up to \$1400
 - f. One to one in-car training session with an NRMA trainer capped at 5 hours valued at up to \$425
5. NRMA Livery must be supplied by the NRMA's approved supplier, Optic Signs.
6. Successful Eligible Applicants with vehicles that have existing dual controls will not be eligible for dual control reimbursement.
7. NRMA will work with preferred suppliers to obtain successful Eligible Applicants competitive fleet discounts, however the relationship for the vehicle purchase or lease remains between the successful Eligible Applicant and the vehicle manufacturer or fleet management company.
8. Honorary NRMA Roadside Membership is valid for NRMA branded vehicles only which are used for the purpose of providing the services outlined in the successful Eligible Applicant's Consultancy Agreement.
9. Successful Eligible Applicants are selected solely at the discretion of NRMA.

10. If:
 - a. the NRMA terminates a Consultancy Agreement prior to end of the term of the relevant Consultancy Agreement; or
 - b. the Eligible Applicant terminates a Consultancy Agreement prior to the end of the term of the relevant Consultancy Agreement; or
 - c. an Eligible Applicant fails to meet any of these Terms and Conditions, the value of the NRMA's outlay in connection to the Incentive must be repaid by the relevant Eligible Applicant to the NRMA on date of termination or when reasonably determined by the NRMA.

Incentive Period

11. The Incentive is available to Eligible Applicants from Monday, 1 September 2018 30 June 2019 (inclusive) or until NRMA Safer Driving Schools deems to withdraw the incentive (**Incentive Period**).

Incentive Activation

12. This Incentive must be taken up by Eligible Applicants during the Incentive Period by signing a Consultancy Agreement with the NRMA Safer Driving School Pty Limited ABN 12 122 086 278.
13. Eligible Applicants must commit to a 3 year term under the Consultancy Agreement.
14. Eligible Applicants must provide the NRMA with a copy of their Registered Training Organisation's invoice for the Certificate IV in Transport and Logistics prior to commencement of the course. If the NRMA approves the course, the subsidy will be paid by the NRMA to the relevant Eligible Applicant in 3 instalments commencing approximately 6 months after the course completion date with a maximum contribution of up to \$4,000.
15. Eligible Applicants must attend all NRMA scheduled training sessions unless otherwise agreed by the NRMA in writing.
16. Eligible Applicants must provide the NRMA with supplier invoices for installation of dual controls and/or livery (as applicable) for reimbursement with maximum contribution of up to \$4,000
17. Eligible Applicants must provide consistent availability throughout the term of the Consultancy Agreement unless otherwise agreed in writing with the NRMA. An Eligible Applicant's availability must comprise of a minimum of 21 hours 'on peak' availability per week. On peak times are between 3.30 pm and 7.00 pm (AEST) Monday to Friday and 8.00 am to 5.00 pm (AEST) Saturday to Sunday during NSW and ACT school terms, or 8.00 am to 5.00 pm (AEST) Monday to Sunday during NSW and ACT school holidays.
