# The itinerary

# Day 1

# Australia - Singapore

Today you'll depart from either Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth bound for Singapore. All meals are included onboard your Singapore Airlines flight and on arrival you'll be transferred to the hotel to enjoy the rest of the day however you like.

Overnight: Furama River Front, Singapore.

# Day 2

## Singapore – Kota Kinabalu

After breakfast at the hotel, hop aboard the shuttle to Singapore Airport for your onward flight to Kota Kinabalu. You'll be met on arrival and transferred to the hotel for check in. In the evening you'll meet the tour group at the hotel and head out to visit the night markets, enjoying a seafood dinner and cultural show.

Overnight: Dreamtel Kota Kinabalu, Kota Kinabalu.

# Day 3

# **Island hopping**Enjoy broakfast

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before meeting the group at 9am and head to the marina jetty, where you'll board the boat to Sapi Island. Spend the morning exploring the island at your own pace before continuing to Manukan island for a BBQ lunch. After lunch you'll have some time to enjoy a swim and snorkel, before heading back to the mainland around 3.30pm. There you'll spend the rest of the day as you like before regrouping for dinner.

Overnight: Dreamtel Kota Kinabalu, Kota Kinabalu.

# Day 4

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## Mari Mari Cultural Village – Kota Kinabalu city

After breakfast at the hotel, meet in the lobby at 9am and head to Mari Mari Cultural Village. Located about 25 minutes away from the city, you'll begin your exploration into Borneo ethnic culture, followed by lunch. In the afternoon enjoy a scenic tour

of Kota Kinabalu city, including the Menara Tun Mustapha, University Malaysia Sabah, Sabah Museum and more before feasting at a local restaurant for dinner.

Each home in Mari Mari Cultural Village was built by descendants of the tribes they represent and offer a truly genuine experience. They're able to portray these tribes through architecture and you'll have the opportunity to acquaint yourself with each tribe as they allow you into these homes. While wandering the village, you'll find demonstration huts where daily activities of their history come to life, including making a traditional fire, tattooing and more.

Overnight: Dreamtel Kota Kinabalu, Kota Kinabalu.

# Day 5

## Kota Kinabalu - Poring Hot Springs — Kundasang War Memorial - Sabah Tea Garden

Have an early breakfast before meeting the tour group in the lobby and bidding farewell to Kota Kinabalu to begin your journey across the north of Borneo. You'll start off with a visit to Kinabalu National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Listed Site.

After lunch, you'll check into the hotel before boarding the bus at 2.30pm to Poring Hot Springs. Take time to unwind and say goodbye to your aches and pains in the spring fed hot mineral water pool. The more adventurous can tackle the challenge of the canopy walk, a series of platforms suspended 41 metres above the forest floor, before heading back to the hotel in time for dinner.

The greatest feature of Kinabalu National park is Mount Kinabalu. An impressive 4,095 metres, it's the second highest mountain in Southeast Asia.

Overnight: Sabah Tea Garden Cottages, Kinabalu Park.

# Day 6

## Sabah Tea Garden — Sandakan

This morning enjoy breakfast at the hotel before checking out and collecting a lunch box to head to Sabah Tea Garden. Visit the tea factory and Quailey's Hill Memorial and proceed to the Fish spa at Kg Luanti. Afterwards, you'll head off on a 4 hour drive to Sandakan and take in the amazing countryside before arriving at the Sandakan War Memorial, situated on the grounds of what was previously the POW camp. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon as you like, before heading to an English tea house for dinner.

Overnight: Sabah Hotel, Sandakan.

# Day 7

### Sandakan - Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre

After breakfast, meet the tour group for a trip to the Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre. Afterwards, take a 5 minute walk to see the remarkable sun bears at the Bornean Sun Bear Conservation Centre. You'll enjoy lunch at Lindung Gallery Restaurant, a charming English tea house overlooking the Sandakan harbour, before an afternoon tour of Sandakan. You'll visit a Chinese Temple, St Michael's Church, Agnes Keith house and a water village. Then you can enjoy the afternoon how you please before dinner at the hotel.

Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre prepares orphaned baby orangutans for their release back to their natural habitats in the wild jungles of Borneo. Keep your camera ready in case you get up close and personal with one and observe the orangutan families and other primates at the feeding platform while soaking up the sights and sounds of the beautiful rainforest environment.

Overnight: Sabah Hotel, Sandakan.

# Day 8

## Sandakan - Rainforest Discovery Centre - Sukau

Enjoy breakfast this morning before heading off to the Rainforest

Discovery Centre. Marvel at the beauty of the Sepilok Rainforest at dawn and immerse yourself in the tree tops, with 250 bird species and other wildlife, on the canopy walk platform. Plant lovers will be thrilled by the diversity of native orchids, slipper orchids, pitcherplants and tropical plants, including the Venus flytrap.

Afterwards drive through the rustic countryside studded with villages to Sukau on the Kinabatangan River. You'll then take a short boat transfer to your lodge for orientation and check in before a late afternoon river cruise to see the proboscis monkeys and other wildlife along the river bank. Afterwards, cruise back to the lodge so you can freshen up for dinner.

*Overnight*: Borneo Nature Lodge or Proboscis Lodge Bukit Melapi, Sukau.

## Day 9

### Kinabatangan River

Take a sunrise cruise at 6am up the Kinabatangan River and onto Kelenanap Ox Bow Lake for bird watching. Return to the lodge for breakfast then explore the large limestone Gomantong Cave before driving back to the lodge to freshen up for lunch and enjoy some free time. In the afternoon meet at the lodge for afternoon tea, then embark on another cruise along the Kinabatangan River to see more of the flora and fauna of the rainforest before heading back to the lodge for dinner.

*Overnight*: Borneo Nature Lodge or Proboscis Lodge Bukit Melapi, Sukau.

# **Day 10**

## Sukau - Sandakan - Kota Kinabalu

After breakfast you'll be off to Sandakan Airport to fly to Kota Kinabalu. Once you've arrived, you'll be taken to your hotel to check in before enjoying a farewell dinner at Kudos Restaurant.

Overnight: Dreamtel Kota Kinabalu, Kota Kinabalu.

## **Voluntary changes**
