Alaskan Wilderness rail journey — Denali National Park

This morning you'll go to the Anchorage Rail Depot where you'll board a deluxe dome railcar for a scenic 3 hour journey north on the Alaskan Railroad Denali Star route to the quaint town of Talkeetna, nestled at the base of Denali. Upon arrival into Talkeetna you'll board a deluxe motor-coach for a scenic transfer north to Denali National Park. Once you're in Denali you'll have the rest of the day at your leisure for optional activities like guided hikes, flight seeing, rafting, as well as many others to choose from (activities not included).

Denali – Alaska Wildlife Conservation Centre – Seward – Alaska Inside Passage cruise

Day 9

Juneau

A city that gracefully balances frontier ruggedness with cosmopolitan flair. Mendenhall Glacier, a river of ice measuring 1.5 miles in width and over 6 miles in length, is part of Juneau's Icefield, 1500 square miles of ice that feeds 38 glaciers.

Day 10 Skagway

Skagway is a compact city in southeast Alaska, set along the popular cruise route the Inside Passage. It's home to gold-rush-era buildings, now preserved as part of the Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park. The White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad runs vintage locomotives past the famously steep Chilkoot trail and offers sweeping mountain views during its climb toward Canada.

Day 11

Icy Strait

For thousands of years, the Tlingit Native Americans have called this place home. Located near the city of Hoonah, and home to a historic cannery, Icy Strait Point also offers travellers the chance to view wildlife like humpback whales, orcas, seals, eagles, and brown bears, or to explore monuments to the region's fishing heritage.

Tour Guide vs Tour Leader

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.Frequent Flyer Points:

To earn Qantas frequent flyer points, please provide frequent flyer numbers at the time of check-in.

Advance seat assignments:

Advance seat assignment is not available. However, customers can choose their seating at time of check in (subject to availability). Customers are unable to purchase seats via QANTAS customer service department, QANTAS website or the NRMA.

Special meals:

Customers can request one of the following special meals:

- Diabetic, gluten intolerance, Hindu, Kosher meal, Muslim (Halal), vegetarian (Lacto Ovo) or vegan
- All dietary requests must be clearly stated on your passenger information form only
- No other form of late requests will be processed by the airline

Cruise:

Disembarkation usually begins 2 hours after docking.

Due to security reasons, all guests must be on board 2 hours before sailing.

Itineraries are subject to change at any time without notice.

Check your specific sailing for exact departure and arrival times. All times are local to the port.

Coach tour

Meals:

22 meals are included in total. For all other meals; lunches and dinners the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. You can also enquire about any allergies and food and if necessary advise meals to be to be prepared with any medication you require.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you must carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and offloading of their luggage from the coach.

Gratuities:

Gratuities (tips) are not included in the tour price for services of the tour leader (when available) and driver throughout the tour.

Other important information

The recommended tip for the tour leader and driver is \$10 USD per person per day, which will be collected whilst on tour. Prepaid gratuities onboard the cruise are included in the package price. Any optional extras purchased onboard the cruise will have up to an 18% gratuity added payable onboard at the end of your cruise.

Fitness level required/mobility:

Our vehicles are not equipped with wheelchair access, so unfortunately our tours are currently not suitable for wheelchair users and those less mobile.

Please note; A basic level of fitness will be required. If you have any concerns please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/travel.

Visas

- If travelling on an Australian Passport, an ESTA (Visa Waiver) for the USA is a strict requirement when travelling to or flying through the USA. Once a USA ESTA Visa Waiver is issued it is valid for 2 years or until your passport expires (whichever is sooner) and will allow multiple entries into the USA.
