The itinerary

Standard 9 day Magical Thailand

Day 1

Australia – Chiang Mai

Today depart Sydney for Chiang Mai, Thailand with Thai Airways, Singapore Airlines, or Virgin Australia. Once you arrive you'll be taken to your hotel for the night.

Due to flight scheduling and availability, some departures may occur on day 0. Affected customers must be at the airport the night before. Flight times will be indicated on your final documents which you will receive prior to departure.

Overnight: Khum Phucome Hotel or similar, Chiang Mai *Meals included*: In flight

Day 2

Chiang Mai – Wat Phra That Doi Suthep Temple

Today visit Wat Phra That Doi Suthep. This impressive golden Buddhist temple is a must see whilst visiting Chiang Mai and is one of the city's most important and visible landmarks. The temple is approached on foot by climbing a steep staircase of 290 steps and is the home of many holy Buddha relics. Located high in the hills above Chiang Mai, this magnificent temple provides an impressive view over the city, so make sure you have your camera ready. Spend the afternoon at your leisure exploring Chiang Mai or join a Thai cooking class.

Overnight: Khum Phucome Hotel or similar, Chiang Mai *Meals included*: Breakfast

Day 3 Chiang Mai – Chiang Rai

This morning you'll begin the journey to Chiang Rai, a pretty town surrounded by countryside and mountains, close to the borders of Laos and Myanmar. Visit Wat Rong Khun, known as the 'White Temple', that's unlike any other in Thailand.

Overnight: The Infinity Suite or similar, Chiang Rai **Meals included**: Breakfast

Day 4

Golden Triangle full day tour

Today you'll travel to the Golden Triangle, the frontier between Laos, Myanmar and Thailand on a full day tour. On the way stop off at a hot spring and Baandam museum and gallery of artist Thawan Duchanee. Then you'll continue on your journey to the Golden Triangle, from the viewpoint you'll be able to see all three neighbouring countries, the Mekong River and hilly landscape. Enjoy a buffet lunch before visiting Mae Sai, a town at the border of Thailand and Myanmar where you can do some shopping. In the afternoon you'll visit the Akha and Yao Hill Tribe communities. It's a great chance to meet the locals and learn about their culture before heading back to Chiang Rai for the evening.

Day 5

Chiang Rai – Bangkok

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, before going to Chiang Rai Airport around midday for your flight to Bangkok. Once you arrive in Bangkok you'll be taken to your hotel for the evening.

Other important information Climate and average temperature

The north of Thailand is known as a cooler place, however you can still expect it to be hot in the summer months. The cooler season runs from December to March, the nights can be cool enough to require a jacket. The heat starts to increase soon after the new year and by April or May it will be hot and humid. During the rainy season the downpours can be extremely heavy, but generally only last for an hour or so in the afternoon.

Bangkok:

The weather in Bangkok is dominated by a tropical monsoon climate, so it's hot all year round. Throughout the year there are three main seasons: hot season from March to June, rainy season from July to October and a cooler season between November and February.

Phuket:

Phuket has a tropical monsoonal climate. It's warm/hot all year round, but it is hottest from April to May. Humidity is high, at this time, which can make the days feel even hotter. September -October is also the wettest, thanks to the southwest monsoon.

Tour Guide vs Tour Leader Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour. They do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

Coach tour

Meals:

8 meals are included in the tour (9 Day Package), for all other meals; lunches and dinners the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. You can also enquire about any allergies and food and if necessary advise meals to be to be prepared with any medication you require.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you must carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and off-loading of the luggage from the coach.



Gratuities:

Gratuities (tips) are not included in the tour price for services of the tour leader (when available) and driver throughout the tour. The recommended tip for the tour leader and driver is \$10 per person per day, which will be collected whilst on tour.

Fitness level required/mobility:

Our vehicles are not equipped with wheelchair access, so unfortunately our tours are currently not suitable for wheelchair users and those less mobile.

Please note: a general level of fitness will be required. The climb to the temple on day 2 will require a moderate level of fitness. If you have any concerns please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/travel.

Visas

A 30 day tourist visa is granted upon arrival if travelling on an Australian passport. Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or a visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.
