

RAIL, REEF & RELAX 11 days / 10 nights 31 August 2018

Day 1 – 31 Aug 18: Depart Sydney, Spirit of Queensland – Brisbane to Cairns

Fly from Sydney to Brisbane this morning. On arrival you will be transferred to Roma Street Station to board the *Spirit of Queensland*. Combining modern seating and entertainment options with the charm of long distance rail travel, the *Spirit of Queensland* is comfortable and convenient. The train departs at 3.45pm and travels overnight to Cairns. You'll travel in a unique Rail Bed, a business class-style seat which converts into a flat bed at night. (D)

Day 2 – 1 Sep 18: Cairns

Arrive into Cairns this afternoon and transfer to your accommodation. (B,L)

Spend up to five hours at the Marine World pontoon snorkelling (instruction is included), witness a fish feeding presentation and take a glass bottom boat tour. Buffet lunch and morning and afternoon teas are included. Take your swimmers and towel, sunblock, hat, sunglasses, camera, and money/credit card for any on-board purchases. (B,L)

Day 5 – 4 Sep 18: Kuranda

Depart today for a full day exploring the rainforest. Transfer to the railway station for the Kuranda Scenic Train and the spectacular views as you journey through fifteen hand cut tunnels and passing spectacular waterfalls.

canopy. After your tour you will be transferred back to your hotel. (B)

Day 7 – 6 Sep 18: Board Pacific Eden
